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TREKKING TOURS LAO THAN ROOF OF Y TY

Duration: 2 Days 1 Night

Transportation: Limousine - Train - Bus

Departure: Every Friday

Lao Than is a place to relax with clouds and wind, where the picture frames can only describe very part little of the grandeur here. Dubbed the roof of Y Ty, the peak of Lao Than is high at 2,860m. In addition, the Mong people call it Hau Pong San. Along the way, you'll come across Friendly Ha Nhi ethnic people with traditional costumes and green scarves picking tobacco leaves in the deep forest. Sometimes crossing burned forests, when villagers burn their fields for farming... When walking on again dry, burnt-gray tree trunks... Or the beautiful scenery of pea flowers bright red azaleas in the afternoon sun

Day 0: Ha Noi – Sapa:

- Depending on the way of travel of different groups that choose and tour time is also different, but the vehicle that people use the most is the car night bus or train.
- Between 21:00 and 23:00, there will be buses departing to Sapa at 70C
 Nguyen Huu Huan or 18C Hang Voi. JBA Travelbox will announce the pick-up time suitable and specific pick-up point with your schedule before the date of departure so that you. Guests have the best preparation for the journey

Day 1: Sapa – Lao Than

- 04:00 After arriving in Sapa, the delegation can rest in the car until 6:00
- 06:00 HDV picks up the delegation and moves to the hotel for breakfast, then a car will pick up the group at the hotel and depart for Lao Than.
- 08:00 The group got on the bus and started moving. Estimated travel time: 4 hours
- Y Ty is a place bordering China, and also a place to discover a unique landscape culture not inferior to Sapa. Located 75km northwest of Sapa.

- On the way from Sapa to Y Ty, the group can stop arbitrarily on the side of the road to admire the beauty of this place, as long as it is safe for themselves and the vehicles on the road. Along the way, the group will see fields of lilies and roses stretching endlessly, terraced fields stretching like endless, Hmong girls and boys both work in the fields and love singing songs. love songs in their own language; looking at ethnic minority students happily carrying books to school, herds of buffaloes and cows moving slowly, and looking back at the members of the group with curious and strange eyes.
- 11:00 Arriving at Y Ty at noon, the group stopped at Homestay A Ho, a progressive Hmong guy. Lunch at Homestay, rest and prepare for moving to the foot of Lao Than mountain in the afternoon
- 13:00 Delegation leaves unnecessary belongings at A Ho homestay and begins the journey to conquer Lao Than mountain, located at an altitude of 2860m – the roof of Y Ty
- On the way to the mountain, the group will have the opportunity to immerse themselves in nature, with forests of apricots, ancient tamarinds, roads with rows of ferns stretching, surrounding mountains, and the climate. cool, very fresh. In particular, Lao Than is a relatively new road, so it is not too crowded, so there are many possibilities that the group will be the only ones to climb this road.
- 16:30 After a journey of climbing about 6km, the group stopped at a shack to sleep. Rest and shower and have dinner
- There was no electricity in the shack at night, so this was an opportunity for the group to admire the entire galaxy in favorable weather conditions.

Day 2: Lao Than – Sapa – Ha Noi

- 04:30 Waking up early in the morning, the group will continue the journey of more than 2km remaining, to touch the roof of Y Ty's house, and admire the beauty of the mountains at dawn, hunt for moments clouds under conditions. good weather.
- 07:00 Delegation down to the shack, have breakfast, rest and pack up, start the journey down the mountain, and return to the porter's house to receive the items.
- 11:00 Delegation stops for lunch and continues the journey back to Sapa.
- 14:30 Return to Sapa, get back your checked baggage at the hotel, and take a shower at the hotel. The group is free to visit Sapa and have dinner at their own expense.
- 22:00 Delegation to sleeper bus back to Hanoi.
- Or the group can choose to return to Hanoi by sleeper bus at 15:30
